HANDBOVER THE ADMINISTRATION OF CERTIFIED QUALITY MARK / CONQUAS SUPERVISOR AND MANAGER SCHEMES (CQMS/CCQS/CQMM/CCQM) TO SCAL

In January 2007, the certified Quality Mark/CONQUAS supervisor and manager schemes were launched to accord recognition to construction personnel who are instrumental in ensuring and delivering projects of high quality as reflected in their high CONQUAS score. The schemes were targeted at project managers/engineers/supervisors that performed QA/QC role to provide a measure on the professional progression of these construction quality personnel. The desired outcome from these schemes was to build up a substantial pool of quality personnel to help raise the overall workmanship quality of the industry.

2 Under the Construction Industry Transformation Map (ITM), Trade Associations and Chambers (TACs) were invited to jointly transform the industry with Building and Construction Authority (BCA). TACs were encouraged to take on a greater role in building the industry's capabilities through for example, taking over of certification schemes that are currently administered by BCA.

3 The Singapore Contractors Association Limited (SCAL) will take over administration of the Certified Quality Mark / CONQUAS Supervisor and Manager Schemes from **1st July 2021**. Through this handover, it creates opportunities for SCAL to take the lead in building industry capabilities, as well as build up its own capability.

4 To facilitate this handover, BCA has stopped accepting new/renewal applications with immediate effect. New and existing certified applicants that are interested to obtain certification can contact SCAL from 1st July 2021.
